Manganese and zinc play an important role in the green and thus the production of the crop.

APPLICATION RATES

Foliar application

(maximum concentration 1:100, unless stated otherwise)

2-5 Times per year; During leaf development.

1.0 litre per hectare.

3-8 Times per year; During leaf development.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Shake or stir well before use.
- Store in a cool dry place away from direct sunlight.
- This product has been tested and can be stored safely at temperatures from 5°C to 25°C. Crystallisation and/or sedimentation may occur below 5°C
